Baylor University's MOAS team represented Colombia at this year's international model, held from March 31-April 3, 2010. For the second straight year, a Baylor student served as President of the Assembly, while two others served as chairs of two of the four committees. A Baylor student was again elected MOAS President for 2011, marking the 3rd consecutive Baylor-held presidency in Washington and the 6th consecutive Baylor presidency for the two MOAS models in which it participates. The model was attended by thirty delegations, representing universities in fourteen states and six different countries.
